Each member of the team must wear the same colour, the default colour being white. Headgear must be white or Club-coloured, whilst jumpers or carigans must be white or cream. Flat-soled shoes must be worn and be brown or predominantly white. No trainers are permitted.

### Rules

In all combination events the following County Rules will apply:-

- 1. There shall be a maximum time limit of 3.1/2 hours.
- 2. Only the skip will be allowed to re-visit the head, this only after his penultimate bowl has been delivered.
  - All other players must stay at the head after playing their bowls.
- 3. Players involved in more than one event may be permitted 15 minutes rest between matches.
- 4. Competitors are not allowed to consume alcohol during the course of play.
